I have suggested that because the update was from 3.4.8 that if you used the manual method then some files were missed and the update didn't complete correctly.

Had it updated correctly then the 'not been converted yet to UTF-8 Multibyte (utf8mb4)' should not show. Your OP suggests that the 'Fix' script fails because of the database not have 'idx\_client\_id\_parent\_id\_alias\_language'

Some 3rd party install packages create the table's fields incorrectly. It looks like the update can't find a field (that it needs to edit) and that is why you are getting the error ?
