

Module de recherche JAK2 FILTER

I've created a page displaying a grid with menu links in each block

The menu type of my links is K2-tag, this way I can match any item who has the same tag as my menu link.

I set the mode to dynamic, filtered by two categories to fetch the items belonging to them and by Extra Field for the countries, dates and prices.

When I run the search for «Polynésie» for exemple the result is returning every item with the extra field country Polynésie selected and not only the ones with the good tag + Polynésie as I would want to.

To solve this issue I thought I could use the pre-filtering so I made a new Extra Field in my Extra Field group named « Thèmes » with the type : Multi-select list and the names of my tags as default values.
